- ii. What is the normal gross margin on subject product(s)? Its level of profit as compared to other product(s) you sell? Please elaborate.
- iii. What percentage of your overall business does the trading of subject product(s) represent in the current year and the last two (2) years?
- iv. Attach a list of your customers who have purchased the subject product(s) from you in the last 2 years and the current year to include volumes, prices and the dates.
- v. Explain the terms and conditions governing sales of the subject product(s) during the last 2 years and the current year, including selling prices, discounts, payment terms, freight policy, unit of measurement, total quantity sold, total gross sales revenue, sales return and allowances, and cash discounts or other discounts. Evidence is required to support the selling prices - price lists that were in place or if price lists were not used, indicate the method used in determining selling prices.

Questions for Importer-Manufacturer

- i. What is/are the subject product(s) used by the company to manufacture or produce another product(s)?
- ii. What is/are the percentage share of the imported subject product(s) to the total cost of production of the finished product(s)? Provide a cost breakdown of the manufactured product(s). Submit a copy of the statement of cost of production of the finished product(s).
- iii. Has the finished product(s) been sold profitably over the period of importation of the subject product(s) or in the last two (2) years (whichever is the lesser)? Elaborate and attach a list of your customer(s) who have purchased your finished product(s) in the last two (2) years and the current year.
- vi. What is the level of sales (volume and value) of company's finished product(s) for the last two (2) years preceding the date of application and the current year? Break up sales information for different models, grades or types, and pricing structures.

- iv. What were the terms and conditions governing sales for all or the majority of your sales of the finished product(s) during the last two (2) years and the current year? Explain to include selling prices, discounts, payment terms, freight policy, unit of measurement, total quantity sold, total gross sales revenues, sales returns and allowances, and cash discounts and other discounts.
